

... and there is also special pay that comes your way with the performance of those highly specialized U. S. Army job assignments . . .

Incentive pay for parachute or demolition duty, or for aerial flights (not as a crewmember) . . . \$55 per month.
Special Pay for Diving Duty. See AR 35-1210.
Combat Pay \$45 per month.
. . . and proficiency pay for skilled technicians which is determined in one of two ways:

- (1) Pay of from one to two pay grades higher; or
- (2) Special proficiency pay as determined by the Department of the Army.

Personnel eligible for proficiency pay may receive from \$50 to \$150 EXTRA pay each month.

In addition, every Army man and woman receives a monthly clothing allowance for uniform maintenance and replacement . . .

- Under 3 years' service . . \$4.20 per month.
- Over 3 years' service . . \$5.40 per month.

. . . in addition to his regular Army monthly pay — and he is free from the danger of layoffs — the U. S. Army man can look forward to a generous retirement income after either 20 or 30 years . . . depression proof security spelled A R M Y

Basic Pay \times Years of Re-Up = Bonus
 (Example: E-4 [over 3 years' service] $\$160 \times 6 = \960.00)

2d Re-Up

$\frac{2}{3}$ Basic Pay \times Years of Re-Up = Bonus
 (Example: E-6 [over 8 years' service] $\$163.33 \times 6 = \979.98)

3d Re-Up

$\frac{1}{3}$ Basic Pay \times Years of Re-Up = Bonus

4th Re-Up

$\frac{1}{6}$ Basic Pay \times Years of Re-Up = Bonus
